Depicts the true story of a Black pianist on concert tour through America's South during the sizzling 1960s. His chauffeur and bodyguard was a tough White bouncer.

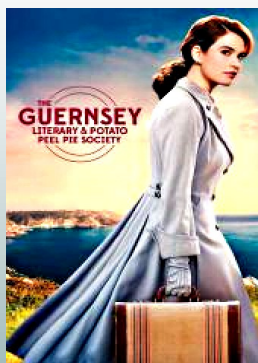
Green Book was

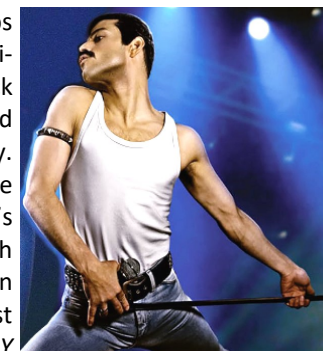

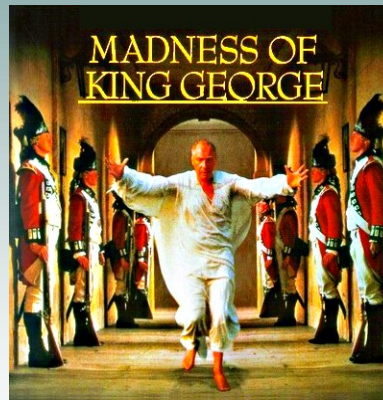

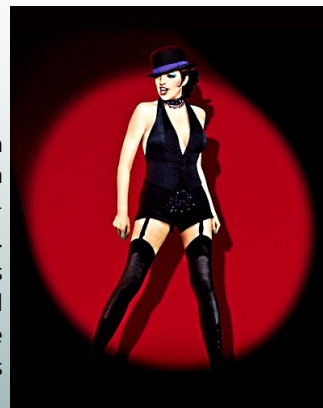
