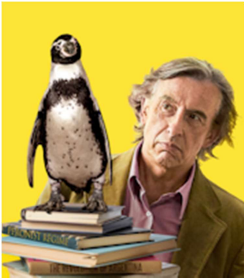
Friday 3rd October **CONCLAVE**

From a 1964 novel, a topical political thriller. Cardinal Lawrence is tasked with leading one of the world's biggest secretive and ancient events, selection of a new Pope. He finds himself encircled in a web of conspiracy and intrigue that could shake the very foundation of the Catholic Church.



Friday 7th November **THELMA**

Thelma Post is a 93-year-old grandma who loses 10,000 dollars to a confidence trickster. With the help of a friend and a motorized scooter, she embarks on a treacherous journey across Los Angeles to reclaim her cash.



Friday 5th December **PENGUIN LESSONS**

A comedy and true story of a disillusioned Englishman who went to teach in a school in Argentina in 1976. Expecting an easy ride, Tom discovers a divided nation and a class of completely unruly students. A must see musical! The untold story of the Witches of Oz focuses on the complex friendship between green-skinned Elphaba and popular Galinda before Dorothy's arrival. Their time at Shiz University and their encounter with the Wizard of Oz, lead to Elphaba becoming the misunderstood Wicked Witch of the West and her friend becoming Glinda the Good. Their lives diverge due to power, politics, and differing moral compasses, the traditional challenge of good versus evil.
