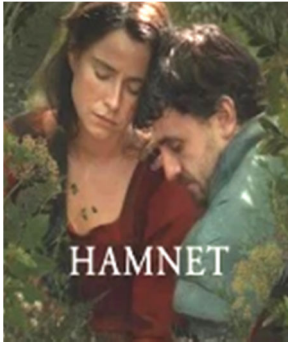


Strathendrick Film Society 2026-2027

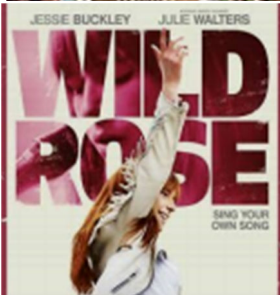
THE BALLAD OF WALLIS ISLAND Friday 6th November

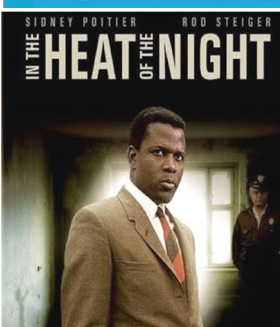
WILD ROSE Friday 5th February
